Sitemap Development


StudioC will draft the initial version of the sitemap for the new website. The sitemap will serve to define the primary architecture and navigation for the site. Additionally, it will serve to quantify pages, page templates and potentially outline page-level components.

StudioC's approach to sitemaps includes visual maps (boxes and arrows), spreadsheet-based (high-level or early-stage) outlines or some combination of both, depending on the project or collaboration needs.

In our experience, the initial version of the sitemap will persist to a high degree, but wireframing the experience will provide further definition and may require minor adjustments along the way.

Design Exploration, Wireframes and Design Layouts

StudioC embraces a component-based design system approach where all website pages and page templates are constructed from purposed-designed components. These components are combined to create full-page design layouts. In the early stages, we work from both ends – design pages to identify discrete components and moving on to leverage the growing component library to construct more page design layouts.


Armed with the insights and definition gained from the previous phases of work, StudioC will explore two distinct design expressions of the home page, global navigation, and up to two additional key pages for client review and selection. The selected design will be the basis for wireframing components and key page templates based on the sitemap. Design layouts will be developed for each wireframe with select additional layouts demonstrating various viewport sizes, page-states or template variations.

The wireframe and design process is inclusive of:


- A mobile-first sensibility

Generally, within the midpoint of the design phase, we move into the website development phase.

Website Development

Using WordPress, StudioC will build a custom theme implementing the UI Designs allowing for full CMS control. We will implement standard SEO tools to account for SEO needs which include page titles, meta descriptions and alt tags.

Content Migration/Entry

During the initial immersion, we will work with you to develop a content migration plan that works for your team and your in-house resources. We would explore automated migration options as well as a plan for manual content entry.

CMS Training

StudioC will provide training to the you team on how to enter and manage content and users within the CMS. We typically plan for 2 (2hr) sessions which are recorded for future reference. We will also provide the instructions in a training document as well.

QA, UAT and Additional Testing

StudioC will conduct quality assurance testing during the development phase and facilitate User Acceptance Testing (UAT) by the client prior to deployment to ensure the experience is operating as intended and expected. We will leverage a third-party ADA-specialized partner to perform an audit of the developed website to validate the site is compliant with all (or relevant and agreed upon portions) of WCAG 2.0 standards.

Deployment and Warranty

StudioC will coordinate and collaborate with your team to deploy the new website, based on the final project plan.

The new website will be covered by a 30-day post-launch warranty period. While we do our best to resolve issues during QA and UAT phases prior to deployment, occasionally undetected issues emerge when the site gets hundreds/thousands of sessions by actual visitors. During the warranty period, StudioC will resolve any previously unidentified bugs within the design specifications. These specifics would be finalized within our formal scope of work.
